Cookies Policy

The objective of this Cookies Policy is to illustrate the types of cookies used on this **Website**, the ways in which they are used and how you can control the use of Cookies.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are sent to your device when you visit a website. They are stored on the hard disk of your device.

Some cookies are deemed strictly-necessary; these cookies are used to facilitate essential tasks on the website, like helping users to navigate between pages in an efficient way and keeping the site functioning securely and efficiently.

Other cookies are used to manage performance and track usage of the site. Ipsen uses these cookies on our sites to help us to understand how our sites are being used so that we can continually improve and develop our sites.

Under the EU Directive 2009/136/EC, we will store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary. When we use other cookies, that are not strictly necessary, we will ask for your permission.

The information collected using cookies does not usually directly identify you. But some cookies may contain personal data, such IP address, date and time of visit to the website, operating system, browser and how the user accesses the site (see the website Privacy Notice for more information about how we process your personal data, your rights and how to contact us).

What cookies does this website use?

This website uses strictly necessary cookies to manage navigation in the site, necessary for user functionality and security.

The site also uses analytics. This provides Ipsen with information about site user behaviour, such as how long users stay on the site, which pages they visit, and which pages are most visited.

How long is information gathered from cookies kept for?

The cookies are set to expire when the information is no longer needed or after a maximum period of 12 months.

How do I set or change my cookie settings?
